12	or division of the University of Arkansas System who is eligible under
13	policies adopted by the Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas and

19	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
20	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that statutes concerning the
21	Arkansas public retirement plans are in need of revision to maintain the
22	public retirement laws in conformance with sound public pension policy; that
23	the state operates on a July 1 to June 30 fiscal year; and that this act is
24	necessary to ensure provisions of this act are effective at the beginning of
25	the fiscal year for ease of administration and operation. Therefore, an
26	emergency is declared to exist, and this act being necessary for the
27	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective
28	on July 1, 2013.
