5	only, specified disease, hospital indemnity, Medicare supplement, long-term
6	care, disability income, or other limited benefit health insurance policy;
7	(2) "Health care insurer" means any insurance company, hospital
8	and medical service corporation, or health maintenance organization issuing
9	or delivering health benefit plans in this state and subject to any of the
10	<u>following laws:</u>
11	(A) The insurance laws of this state;

27	(b) An insurer shall not impose a copayment, coinsurance, or an office
28	visit deductible amount or a combination of a copayment, coinsurance, or an

30	for a date of service by a licensed physical therapist, occupational
31	therapist, or speech-language pathologist that is greater than the copayment,
32	coinsurance, or office visit deductible amount charged to the insured for an
33	office visit for the service of a licensed primary care physician or
34	osteopath.
35	(c) An insurer shall state in its health benefit plan:
36	(1) The availability of physical therapy, occupational therapy,

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(2) All related limitations, conditions, and exclusions.
