2	(2) Issues to be studied by the task force include without		
3	limitation:		
4	(A) A needs assessment to evaluate the:		
5	(i) Number of current and future Arkansas veterans		
6	who have a need for such a facility; and		
7	(ii) Extent of services to be offered by any		
8	Arkansas Veterans Home or homes.		
9	(B) The location or locations for facilities, to include		
10	an evaluation of:		
11	(i) Whether existing facilities are available to		
12	meet the needs identified in subdivision (h)(2)(A) of this section; and		
13	(ii) Possible locations for new facilities;		
14	(C) The cost of design and construction of new facilities		
15	or of utilizing existing facilities; and

18	(i) On or before October 31, 2013, the task force shall submit its		
19	report containing its findings and recommendations to the:		
20	(1) House Committee on Aging, Children and Youth, Legislative

22	(2) Senate Committee on Public Health, Welfare and Labor.		
23	(j) The Bureau of Legislative Research shall provide staff for the		
24	task force.

26	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
27	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that Arkansas veterans are not		
28	receiving the care and security to which they are entitled as a result of		
29	their valuable service to the State of Arkansas and the United States of		
30	America, and that exploration and implementation of alternatives for the care		
31	of those veterans in need of institutional and other care are of immediate		
32	concern and should be among the highest priorities of the General Assembly.		
33	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately		
34	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall		
35	become effective on:		
36	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

1	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
2	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
3	<u>bill; or</u>
4	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
5	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
