Any computations made by the Department 4 of Higher Education and the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board in 5 determining levels of recommended funding for the University of Arkansas at 6 Pine Bluff shall include 100% matching funds for the 1890 Research and 7 Extension Programs in the base. 8 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 9 10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL 11 ALLOWANCES. For the purpose of providing necessary allowances for housing and 12 other unusual expenses incurred by or in behalf of the athletic director, 13 associate/assistant athletic directors, head coaches, and assistant coaches at the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, the Board of Trustees may make 14 15 special allowances available therefore in such amounts as the Board of Trustees may determine as justified, an equitable allowance in view of the 16 17 unusual and exacting duties of said athletic director, associate/assistant athletic directors, head coaches, and assistant coaches, and for the purpose 18 19 of providing such allowances, the Board of Trustees is authorized to expend 20 from the auxiliary income of the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, which is derived from athletic event receipts, an amount not to exceed twenty 21 22 thousand dollars (\$20,000) in the aggregate for such purposes during each 23 fiscal year for the athletic director and head coaches, and ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) in the aggregate for such purposes during each fiscal year 24 25 for the associate/assistant athletic directors and assistant coaches. 22	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
23	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
24	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of
25	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
26	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
27	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm
28	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
29	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
30	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
31	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
