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30	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - QUICK ACTION CLOSING FUND. There is hereby		
31	appropriated, to the Economic Development Commission, to be payable from the		
32	Economic Development Incentive Quick Action Closing Fund, the following:		
33	(A) for incentives to attract new business and economic development to		
34	the State, in a sum not to exceed\$50,000,000.		
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36	SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - INNOVATE ARKANSAS. There is hereby		

1 appropriated, to the Economic Development Commission, to be payable from the 2 Innovate Arkansas Fund, the following: 3 (A) for funds to provide assistance to start-up technology oriented 4 businesses, in a sum not to exceed......\$5,000,000. 5 6 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVE PROGRAM -7 CREATE REBATE. There is hereby appropriated, to the Economic Development 8 Commission, to be payable from the Economic Development Incentive Fund of the 9 Arkansas Economic Development Commission, the following: 10 (A) for financial incentives to companies locating a new facility or 11 expanding an existing facility within the state of Arkansas and for companies 12 that hire and maintain specified levels of employment, as identified in signed financial agreements, in a sum not to exceed..........\$37,500,000. 13 14 15 SECTION 5. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor 16 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects 17 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available 18 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and 19 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and 20 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or 21 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State 22 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects 23 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds 24 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General 25 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall 26 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act. 27 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing 28 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue 29 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State 30 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, 31 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any 32 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law. 33 34 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for

Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

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1	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
2	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
3	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
4	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
5	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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7	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
8	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
9	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
10	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of
11	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
12	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
13	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm
14	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
15	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
16	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
17	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
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
