16	of the director of the Department of Health, is repealed.		
17	(2)(A) The Governor shall appoint the Director of the Departmen		
18	of Health if established, and otherwise the Director of the Division of		
19	Health of the Department of Health and Human Services.		
20	(B) The director shall:		
21	(i) Serve as the executive head of the Department of		
22	Health or the Division of Health of the Department of Health and Human		
23	Services;		
24	(ii) Serve at the pleasure of the Governor;		
25	(iii) Act as the Secretary for the State Board of

27	(iv) Serve as the State Health Officer, with
