## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO ALLOW FOR TWO SPECIAL RETIRED MILITARY
LICENSE PLATES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO ALLOW FOR TWO SPECIAL RETIRED MILITARY LICENSE PLATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-24-206 is amended to read as follows: 27-24-206. Fees and limitations.
(a)(1) Except as provided in subdivision subdivisions (a)(2) and (b)(2) of this section, special license plates created and issued under this subchapter shall be free of charge to an eligible applicant.
(2) To defray the cost of the issuance and renewal of the first special license plates plate under this subchapter, the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration may charge an annual fee for renewal not to exceed one dollar (\$1.00).
(b)(l) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, a person who is eligible to receive a special license plate under this chapter shall be limited to one (1) two (2) special license plate plates under this subchapter.
(2) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, a second special license plate under this section shall be issued upon payment of the fee for licensing a motor vehicle.
(c) An eligible applicant for the issuance or renewal of any of the following special license plates may obtain one (l) additional special
license plate under this subchapter upon payment of a fee not to exceed one dollar (\$1.00):
(1) Ex-prisoner of War;
(2) Pearl Harbor Survivor;
(3) Medal of Honor Recipient;
(4) Disabled Veteran;
(5) Disabled Veteran - World War I; or
(6) Purple Heart Recipient.
