1 offense of failing to comply with registration and reporting requirements, is 2 amended to read as follows: (a)(1)(A) A person is guilty of a Class C felony who: 3 4 (i) Fails to register or verify registration as 5 required under this subchapter; 6 (ii) Fails to report a change of address, 7 employment, education, or training as required under this subchapter; or 8 (iii) Refuses to cooperate with the assessment process as required under this subchapter.; or 9 10 (iv) Files false paperwork or documentation 11 regarding verification, change of information, or petitions to be removed 12 from the registry. 13 14 SECTION 3.
