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23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 7, Chapter 1, is amended to add an
26	additional section to read as follows:
27 28	<u>7-1-111. Voter Integrity Unit — Creation.</u> (a) There is created a Voter Integrity Unit.
29	(b) The Voter Integrity Unit shall be composed of four (4) members of
30	the staff of the Secretary of State who are designated by the Secretary of
31	State, including:
32	(1) The Director of the Elections Division of the Secretary of
33	State, or a designee selected by the Secretary of State, to serve as Chairman
34	of the Voter Integrity Unit;
35 36	(2) The General Counsel of the Secretary of State; (3) One (1) employee of the Elections Division of the Secretary
37	of State; and
38	(4) One (1) officer of the State Capitol Police.
39	(c) The Voter Integrity Unit shall investigate any complaint of



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1	election irregularity or alleged violation of election law that has been
2	filed with the State Board of Election Commissioners.
3	(d) The Voter Integrity Unit shall:
4	(1)(A) Conduct an investigation of each complaint of election
5	irregularity or alleged violation of election law.
6	(B) In the course of an investigation, the Voter Integrity
7	<u>Unit may:</u>
8	(i) Conduct a hearing;
9	(ii) Use the power of subpoena to compel the:
10	(a) Attendance and testimony of a witness; and
11	(b) Production of evidence, including without
12	limitation books, records, or other documents; and
13	(iii) Administer an oath for the purpose of taking
14	sworn testimony; and
15	(2) Render a report on the result of the investigation to the
16	<u>Secretary of State.</u>
17	(e) Within thirty (30) calendar days of receiving the report, the
18	Secretary of State shall present the results of the report to a meeting of
19	the State Board of Election Commissioners.
20	(f) The State Board of Election Commissioners shall receive the report
21	and within thirty (30) calendar days from receipt of the report determine an
22	official response from the board, including without limitation:
23	(1) Dismissal of the complaint of election irregularity or
24	<u>violation of election law;</u>
25	(2) Issue of a letter of caution to individuals or entities
26	responsible for election irregularity; or
27	(3) Referral of the instance of alleged election law violation
28	<u>to:</u>
29	(A) The prosecuting attorney for the jurisdiction in which
30	the alleged election law violation occurred; or
31	(B) The United States Attorney for the jurisdiction in
32	which the alleged election law violation occurred.
33	<u>(g) Within sixty (60) calendar days of determining the official</u>
34	response of the State Board of Election Commissioners to the instance of
35	election irregularity or alleged violation of election law, the State Board
36	of Election Commissioners shall submit to the House Committee of State

18	Commissioners regarding disposition of the complaint of election irregularity
19	or alleged election law violation; and
20	(C) Copies of any referrals to prosecutors or United
