25	SECTION 1. A	rkansas Code § 7-4-101(f) through (h), cond	cerning certain
26	powers and function	s of the State Board of Election Commission	ners, is amended
27	to read as follows:		
28	(f) The boar	d shall have the authority to Secretary of	State may:
29	(1) Pu	blish a candidate's election handbook, in o	conjunction with
30	the office of the S	ecretary of State <u>State Board of Election</u> (<u>Commissioners</u>
31	and the Arkansas Et	hics Commission, which outlines in a readal	ble and
32	understandable form	at the legal obligations of a candidate and	d any other
33	suggestions that mi	ght <u>the Secretary of State determines to</u> be	e helpful to a
34	candidate in comply	ing with state election law;	
35	(2) Con	nduct statewide training for election offic	cers and county
36	election commission	arc.

- (4) Monitor all election law-related legislation;
- 5 (5) Formulate, adopt, and promulgate all necessary rules to 6 assure even and consistent application of voter registration laws and fair 7 and orderly election procedures;
- 8 (6)(A) Appoint certified election monitors to any county upon a 9 signed, written request under oath filed with the board and a determination 10 by the board that appointing a monitor is necessary.
- 11 (B) Certified election monitors shall serve as observers 12 for the purpose of reporting to the board on the conduct of the election.
- 13 (C) The board may allow for reasonable compensation for l4 election monitors;
- 15 (7) Assist the county board of election commissioners in the 16 performance of administrative duties of the election process if the board 17 determines that assistance is necessary and appropriate;
- 18 (8)(A) Formulate, adopt, and promulgate all necessary rules to
 19 establish uniform and nondiscriminatory administrative complaint procedures
 20 consistent with the requirements of Title IV of the federal Help America Vote
 21 Act.
- 22 (B) The cost of compliance with Title IV of the federal
 23 Help America Vote Act shall be paid from the fund established to comply with
 24 the federal Help America Vote Act;
- 25 (9) Investigate alleged violations, render findings, and impose 26 disciplinary action according to § 7-4-118 for violations of election and 27 voter registration laws, except as to § 7-1-103(a)(1)-(4), (6), and (7), and 28 except for any matters relating to campaign finance and disclosure laws which 29 the Arkansas Ethics Commission shall have the power and authority to enforce 30 according to §§ 7-6-217 and 7-6-218;
- 31 (10) Examine and approve in accordance with §§ 7-5-503 and 7-5-32 606 the types of voting machines and electronic vote tabulating devices used 33 in any election; and
- 34 (11) Administer reimbursement of election expenses to counties 35 in accordance with § 7-7-201(a) for primary elections, statewide special 36 elections, and nonpartisan judicial general elections.

11	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 7-4-118(e)(3), concerning moneys received		
12	by the State Board of Election Commissioners in payment of fines, is amende		
13	to read as follows:		
14	(3) All moneys received by the board in payment of fines		
15	shall be deposited into the State Treasury as general revenues <u>County Voting</u>		
16	System Grant Fund, under § 19-5-1247.

18	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 7-4-118(g)(2), concerning records of		
19	inquiries, investigations, and proceedings of the State Board of Election		
20	Commissioners, is amended to read as follows:		
21	(2) Records relating to investigations by the board are exempt		
22	from the Freedom of Information Act of 1967, § 25-19-101 et seq., until a		
23	hearing is set or the investigation by the $\frac{\text{Director}}{\text{Chair}}$ of the $\frac{\text{State}}{\text{Board}}$		
24	of Election Commissioners is closed.		
25			
26	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code Title 7, Chapter 4, Subchapter 1, is amended		
27	to add an additional section to read as follows:		
28	7-4-120. State Board of Election Commissioners — Transfer.		
29	(a) The State Board of Election Commissioners is transferred to the		
30	Office of the Secretary of State by a type 1 transfer, under § 25-2-104,		
31	under which the departments, institutions, other agencies, or parts thereof,		
32	shall be administered under the direction and supervision of that principal		
33	department, but shall retain the same prescribed statutory powers,		
34	authorities, duties, and functions as the board had before the transfer,		
35	including:		
36	(1) Rulemaking regulation licencing and registration.		

1	(2) The promutgation of rules, rates, regulations, and
2	standards; and
3	(3) The rendering of findings, orders, and adjudications.
4	(b) The State Board of Election Commissioners shall exercise those
5	powers, authorities, duties, and functions independently of the head of the
6	principal department.
7	
8	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
9	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the State Board of Election
10	Commissioners is a substantial component of the election process, that
11	effective elections are essential to the preservation of citizens' right to
12	vote, and that it is necessary to complete the transfer of the State Board of
13	Election Commissioners before the 2013 annual school election. Therefore, ar
14	emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for
15	the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become
16	effective on and after July 1, 2013.
