SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 13 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that under § 25-15-105, the 14 15 authority of the State Board of Examiners of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse 16 Counselors to charge certain fees currently collected by the board will 17 expire on July 1, 2013, and that this act is necessary to allow the board to 18 continue to collect the revenues it currently receives and to allow the board to maintain its current level of operation. Therefore, an emergency is 19 20 declared to exist, and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2013. 21 22
