19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE	GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF AR	RKANSAS:

21	SECTION 1. APPR	OPRIATION - PREPAYMENT OF UCC FEES.	There is hereby
22	appropriated, to the	Secretary of State, to be payable f	from the Prepayment of
23	UCC Fees Fund, for pe	rsonal services and operating expen	ises for the payment
24	of a remitter's filin	g fees, termination fees, indexing	a record, search or
25	copy requests and rel	ated expenses related to the prepay	ment of UCC fees for
26	the fiscal year endin	g June 30, 2013, the sum of	\$250,000.

28	SECTION 2. COMP	LIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disburseme	ent of funds
29	authorized by this ac	t shall be limited to the appropria	ation for such agency
30	and funds made availa	ble by law for the support of such	appropriations; and
31	the restrictions of t	he State Procurement Law, the Gener	cal Accounting and
32	Budgetary Procedures	Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law,	the Regular Salary
33	Procedures and Restri	ctions Act, or their successors, an	nd other fiscal
34	control laws of this	State, where applicable, and regula	ations promulgated by
35	the Department of Fin	ance and Administration, as authori	zed by law, shall be
36	strictly complied wit	h in disbursement of said funds.

2	SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General		
3	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations		
4	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for		
5	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive		
6	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget		
7	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters,		
8	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislativ		
9	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.		
10			
11	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General		
12	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the		
13	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the		
14	effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and approval is		
15	essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this		
16	Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative		
17	session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond the date of its		
18	passage and approval could work irreparable harm upon the proper		
19	administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,		
20	an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the		
21	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in		
22	full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
