4	(b)(1) Each quarter following the assumption of authority by the state		
5	board or commissioner, the commissioner shall provide to the chairs of the		
6	House Committee on Education and the Senate Committee on Education, a status		
7	report indicating the progress of the school district toward removing itself		
8	from the authority of the state board or the commissioner.		
9	(2) The commissioner also shall provide a copy of the status		
10	report required under subdivision (b)(1) of this section to each member of		
11	the General Assembly who represents the area in which the school district is		
12	<u>located.</u>		
13	(c) A person appointed by the state board or the commissioner to		
14	operate a school district under the authority of the state board or the		
15	<u>commissioner shall not have previously been an administrator responsible for</u>		
16	<u>a school district that was placed in fiscal distress, academic distress,</u>		
17	facilities distress, or in violation of the Standards for Accreditation of		
18	Arkansas Public Schools and School Districts.		
19	(d)(1) After a school district has been under the authority of the		
20	state board or the commissioner for two (2) consecutive school years, the		
21	<u>commissioner shall:</u>		
22	(A) Conduct a review of each person appointed by the state		
23	board or commissioner to operate the school district;		
24	(B) Determine whether the person has made satisfactory		
25	progress toward removing the school district from the authority of the state		
26	board or the commissioner; and		
27	(C) Determine whether the person should continue to		
28	operate the school district or be replaced.		
29	(2) The commissioner shall report the results of this review to		
30	the state board and each member of the General Assembly who represents the		
31	area in which the school district is located.		
32	(3) The report shall include a justification of the		
33	determination made under subdivision (d)(1) of this section.		
34	(e) Before the appointment of an interim school board, permanent		
35	school board, or community advisory board for the school district under the		
36	authority of the state board or the commissioner, the commissioner or the		

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1	state board through the commissioner, shall seek recommendations for		
2	individuals to serve as members of the interim school board, permanent schoo		
3	board, or community advisory board from the members of the General Assembly		
4	who represent the area in which the school district is located.
