1	Future of Higher Education within thirty (30) days of the effective date of
2	this act and shall serve as the chair at the first meeting.
3	(2) At the first meeting of the Vision 2025 Legislative
4	Commission on the Future of Higher Education, the Vision 2025 Legislative
5	Commission on the Future of Higher Education members shall elect a chair from
6	its legislative membership.
7	(3)(A) The Vision 2025 Legislative Commission on the Future of
8	Higher Education shall conduct its meetings in Pulaski County at the State
9	Capitol or other locations in the state as determined by the chair.
10	(B) At least one (1) meeting shall be held every three (3)
11	months but may occur more often as determined by the chair.
12	(d) If a vacancy occurs on the Vision 2025 Legislative Commission on
13	the Future of Higher Education, the vacancy shall be filled by the same
14	process as the original appointment.
15	(e) The Vision 2025 Legislative Commission on the Future of Higher
16	Education shall establish rules and procedures for conducting the business of
17	the Vision 2025 Legislative Commission on the Future of Higher Education.
18	(f) Members of the Vision 2025 Legislative Commission on the Future of
19	Higher Education shall serve without compensation but may receive
20	reimbursement according to § 25-16-902.
21	(g) The Vision 2025 Legislative Commission on the Future of Higher
22	Education may expend funds and resources in carrying out the commission's
23	purpose and responsibilities that are appropriated and funded to the
24	commission by the General Assembly.
25	(h) A majority of the members of the Vision 2025 Legislative
26	Commission on the Future of Higher Education shall constitute a quorum for
27	transacting business of the Vision 2025 Legislative Commission on the Future
28	of Higher Education.
29	(i) The Bureau of Legislative Research shall provide staff for the
30	Vision 2025 Legislative Commission on the Future of Higher Education.

32	SECTION 3. DO NOT CODIFY. Purpose and responsibilities.
33	(a)(1) The Vision 2025 Legislative Commission on the Future of Higher
34	Education shall study, research, and brainstorm ways in which higher
35	education can transform and positively impact the state by 2025 and beyond
36	2025.

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1	(2) As a part of the commission's duty to study, research, and				
2	brainstorm ways in which higher education can transform and positively impact				
3	the state, the commission shall:				
4	(A) Explore what is required to:				
5	(i) Create a culture of college success as				
6	fundamental expectation for all students; and				
7	(ii) Reach the Governor's 2025 goal of the number of				
8	Arkansans with a degree or certificate from an institution of higher				
9	education;				
10	(B) Identify the role that higher education plays in:				
11	(i) Improving the quality of life for all Arkansans;				
12	and				
13	(ii) Contributing to economic opportunity and				
14	expansion;				
15	(C) Study barriers that impede access to higher education				
16	and ways to remove them, including without limitation;				
17	(i) The cost of tuition, fees, and room and board;				
18	(ii) Scholarship and grant funding availability; and				
19	(iii) Affordability, including ways to promote and				
20	encourage families to save for college; and				
21	(D) Identify how research opportunities can aid the state				
22	in achieving and surpassing the Governor's 2025 goals and beyond, including				
23	the identification of clear strategies to attract research opportunities to				
24	the state.				
25	(b)(1) The commission shall develop a progress report and a final				
26	report that includes a set of recommendations for the General Assembly that				
27	will detail the work of the commission required under subsection (a) of this				
28	section.				
29	(2)(A) The commission shall present the progress report and the				
30	final report to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the				
31	Speaker of the House of Representatives, the House Committee on Agriculture,				
32	Forestry, and Economic Development, the Senate Committee on Agriculture,				
33	Forestry, and Economic Development, and the public.				
34	(B) The progress report is due no later than November 1,				
35	2014 and the final report is due not later than November 1, 2018.				
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1	SECTION 4. DO NOT CODIFY. Expiration of the Vision 2025 Legislative	
2	Commission on the Future of Higher Education.	
3	The Vision 2025 Legislative Commission on the Future of Higher	
4	Education shall cease to exist on January 1, 2019.
