## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE ARKANSAS AGRICULTURE DEPARTMENT  
9 TO STUDY THE BENEFITS OF ENTERING INTO AGRICULTURAL  
10 EXCHANGES WITH OTHER COUNTRIES; TO REQUIRE THE  
11 ARKANSAS AGRICULTURE DEPARTMENT TO REPORT TO THE  
12 GENERAL ASSEMBLY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

15 TO REQUIRE THE ARKANSAS AGRICULTURE  
16 DEPARTMENT TO STUDY THE BENEFITS OF  
17 ENTERING INTO AGRICULTURAL EXCHANGES WITH  
18 OTHER COUNTRIES; AND TO REQUIRE THE  
19 ARKANSAS AGRICULTURE DEPARTMENT TO REPORT  
20 TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
25

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 25, Chapter 38, Subchapter 2, is  
27 amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

28 25-38-210. Agricultural exchanges.

29 The Arkansas Agriculture Department shall:

30 (1) Evaluate the potential economic benefits to Arkansas and  
31 Arkansas farmers of entering into agricultural exchanges with Israel and  
32 other countries that will foster the development of trade, mutual assistance,  
33 and business relations between Arkansas and the other country; and

34 (2) Annually report the department's findings under subdivision  
35 (1) of this section to the House Committee on Agriculture, Forestry, and  
36 Economic Development and the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Forestry, and
