20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

6 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PARK  
8 BUDGET ALLOCATION. Prior to July 1 of each fiscal year, the Legislative  
9 Council or the Joint Budget Committee shall review the Parks and Tourism

25 MAINTENANCE. The funds appropriated in Section 5 of this Act for Parks and  
26 Tourism Special Maintenance shall be expended, after receiving prior approval  
27 by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, for a special

1 ATTRACTION FEASIBILITY GRANT PROGRAM. Of the funds appropriated to the  
2 Department of Parks and Tourism for grants by Item (05) in Section 3 of this  
3 Act, the Department is authorized to make grants to cities and counties on a  
4 one to one dollar matching basis, up to \$15,000 in state funds per grant, for  
5 the purpose of feasibility studies for tourism attractions. The Department  
6 is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations for the administration of  
7 this tourism attraction feasibility grant program. The Department of Parks  
8 and Tourism shall notify House and Senate Legislators representing the  
9 district of the award recipient.

10 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2012~~  
11 2013 through June 30, ~~2013~~ 2014.

12  
13 SECTION 28. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
14 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
15 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
16 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
17 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
18 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
19 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
20 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
21 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

22  
23 SECTION 29. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
24 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
25 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
26 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
27 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
28 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
29 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
30 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

31  
32 SECTION 30. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
33 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
34 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
35 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of  
36 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.

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
