- 20 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
- 21 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the current process for the
- 22 payment of salaries for trial court administrative assistants and court
- 23 reporters is inadequate to provide the necessary funding to meet current
- 24 payroll requirements; that the payment of salaries to ensure the
- 25 <u>uninterrupted service of trial court administrative assistants and court</u>
- 26 reporters is essential to the administration of justice and the judicial
- 27 system; and that this act is immediately necessary to provide the Chief
- 28 Fiscal Officer of the State with the authority to provide for the payments.
- 29 Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately
- 30 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall

- 32 <u>(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;</u>
- 33 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
- 34 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
