20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby
23 established for the Arkansas Public Defender Commission - State Operations
24 for the 2013-2014 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular
25 employees.

7 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized,
 8 for the Arkansas Public Defender Commission - State Operations for the 2013-
 9 2014 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary
 10 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated
 11 herein for such purposes: three (3) temporary or part-time employees, when
 12 needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform
 13 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the
 14 appropriate classification.

16 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby
 17 appropriated, to the Arkansas Public Defender Commission, to be payable from
 18 the State Central Services Fund, for personal services and operating expenses

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27 SECTION 5. EXTRA HELP - TRIAL PUBLIC DEFENDER OFFICE. There is hereby
 28 authorized, for the Arkansas Public Defender Commission - Trial Public
 29 Defender Office for the 2013-2014 fiscal year, the following maximum number
 30 of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable
 31 from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: three (3) temporary or
 32 part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those
 33 provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its
 34 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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36 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - TRIAL PUBLIC DEFENDER OFFICE. There is

 35 appropriated, to the Arkansas Public Defender Commission, to be payable from
 36 the State Central Services Fund, for personal services of the Arkansas Public

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10 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FEE
 12 GENERATION AND SUPPORT - COURTS. Unless specified otherwise in Arkansas Code
 13 §5-4-303(g) and Arkansas Code 16-87-213 the monies collected by the courts
 14 under the authority of §5-4-303(g) and 16-87-213 shall be deposited into the
 15 State Treasury to the credit of the State Central Services Fund.

16 In the event that the law requires that the fees levied under §5-4-303(g)
 17 be deposited into the State Administration of Justice Fund, the State
 18 Treasurer shall transfer the amount of the fees collected each month under
 19 the authority of Arkansas Code §5-4-303(g) from the State Administration of
 20 Justice Fund to the State Central Services Fund.

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2012~~
 22 2013 through June 30, ~~2013~~ 2014.

24 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FEE
 26 GENERATION AND SUPPORT - BAIL BOND FEES. Unless specified otherwise in
 27 Arkansas Code §17-19-301(e) the monies collected by each bail bond company
 28 under the authority of §17-19-301(e) shall be deposited into the State
 29 Treasury to the credit of the Public Defender User Fees Fund within the State
 30 Central Services Fund.

31 Of the fee collected by each licensed professional bail bond company,
 32 three dollars (\$3.00) shall be transferred to the various Counties for the
 33 sole purpose of defraying the operating expenses of the local public
 34 defenders' office. The remaining monies collected shall be used to defray
 35 operating expenses of the Commission.

36 On a quarterly basis, from the Bail Bond-County Public Defender line item,

1 the Commission shall remit to each County its portion of the three dollars
2 (\$3.00) per bail bond fee collected based upon the formula used for state aid
3 for counties. This formula is as follows: 75% of the money is distributed
4 equally to all 75 Counties and the remaining 25% is distributed per capita.

5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2012~~
6 2013 through June 30, ~~2013~~ 2014.

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8 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
10 PROVISION. If the Public Defender Commission should determine that the
11 appropriations made available for payments to the Counties are insufficient,
12 appropriation may be transferred from the Public Defender Commission Program
13 line item to the Bail Bond-County Public Defender line item, after receiving
14 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2012~~
16 2013 through June 30, ~~2013~~ 2014.

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18 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DUTIES OF
20 DEPENDENCY-NEGLECT APPEALS ATTORNEY. The Public Defender Commission shall
21 utilize Dependency-Neglect Appeals Attorneys exclusively to write appeals in
22 dependency-neglect cases.

23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2012~~
24 2013 through June 30, ~~2013~~ 2014.

26 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PUBLIC
28 DEFENDERS. (a) No funds appropriated herein shall be used for expenses in
29 cases where a defendant is represented by retained counsel where retained
30 counsel have not gone through the Public Defender Commission's attorney
31 certification procedure and designation process as established by state law
32 and the Commission's regulations. All defendants and retained attorneys must
33 strictly adhere to the procedure established by the Commission to equitably
34 and responsibly monitor and distribute State funds for this purpose.

35 (b) The Public Defender Commission may approve exemptions to subsection
36 (a) as needed. Reasons for granting exemption should be specified in writing.

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2012~~
2 2013 through June 30, ~~2013~~ 2014.

3
4 SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
5 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
6 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
7 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
9 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
10 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
11 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
12 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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14 SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
15 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
16 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
17 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
18 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
19 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
20 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
21 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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23 SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
24 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
25 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
26 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of
27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
28 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
29 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm
30 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
31 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
32 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
33 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
