Arkansas Code § 25-15-204(e)(1)(A), concerning the effective date of administrative rules, is amended to read as follows: (e)(1)(A) Each rule adopted by an agency is effective thirty (30) sixty (60) days after filing of the final rule unless a later date is specified by law or in the rule itself. SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 25-15-204(e)(2)(A)(i), concerning the effective date of emergency rules, is amended to read as follows: (2)(A)(i) However, an emergency rule may become effective immediately upon filing or at a stated time less than thirty (30) sixty (60) days after filing if the agency finds that this effective date is necessary because of imminent peril to the public health, safety, or welfare.
