## For An Act To Be Entitled

an act to adjust Weekly unemployment benefit amounts TO THE EXPIRATION OF THE FEDERAL NONREDUCTION RULE ON BENEFITS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO ADJUST WEEKLY UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFIT AMOUNTS TO THE EXPIRATION OF THE FEDERAL NONREDUCTION RULE ON BENEFITS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Effective on the latter of January l, 2014, or the date the federal nonreduction rule on benefits expires under the American Taxpayer Relief Act of 2012, Pub. L. No. 112-240, Arkansas Code § 11-10502(c), concerning weekly benefit amount for unemployment benefits, is amended to read as follows:
(c)(1)(A) A weekly benefit amount shall not be greater than sixty-six and two-thirds percent ( $662 / 3 \%$ ) of the state average weekly wage for insured employment for the previous calendar year for benefit years beginning after June 30, 1985.
(2) However, effective July 1, 2012, the weekly maximum benefit amount established in subdivision (c)(1) of this section shall not be greater than four hundred fifty-one dollars (\$451) sixty percent (60\%) of the state average weekly wage for insured employment for the previous calendar year.
(B) However, the weekly maximum benefit amount established in subdivision (c)(l)(A) of this section shall not be greater than three hundred twenty-five dollars (\$325).
(2) A weekly benefit amount at a level below the maximum weekly benefit amount shall be reduced by ten percent (10\%) from the current level.
