2	(2)(A) "Event ticket" means a physical, electronic, or other
3	form of a certificate, document, voucher, or token that indicates the bearer,
4	possessor, or individual is entitled to:

7	in an event; or
8	(ii) Purchase the right, privilege, or license with
9	respect to one (1) or more future events.

12	(3) "Person" means a natural person, partnership, corporation,
13	association, or other legal entity;
14	(4)(A) "Resale" includes any form of transfer or alienation, or
15	an offer for transfer or alienation, of possession or entitlement to
16	possession of an event ticket from one (1) person to another, with or without
17	consideration, by means of an Internet website.
18	(B) "Resale" does not include the initial sale of an event

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23	4-88-903. Internet sale of event tickets in excess of printed price.
24	(a)(1) A person may offer for resale an event ticket on the Internet
25	at any price, including a price greater than the price on the face of the
26	<u>ticket.</u>
27	(2) After receipt of payment, the event ticket may be delivered
28	by mail, delivery service, or facsimile, email, Internet, or other electronic
29	means.
30	(b) A person that offers an event ticket for resale shall:
31	(1) Maintain a toll-free telephone number for complaints and
32	inquiries regarding the status of the event ticket; and
33	(2) Provide a full refund to a person that purchases an event
34	ticket if:
35	(A) The event is canceled before the scheduled occurrence
36	of the event and is not rescheduled.

1	(B) The event ticket is counterfeit;
2	(C) The event ticket is canceled by the ticket issuer for
3	nonpayment by the original purchaser or for any reason other than an act or
4	omission of the purchaser of the event ticket;
5	(D) The event ticket materially and to the detriment of
6	the purchaser of the event ticket fails to conform to the description
7	provided by the seller or reseller; or
8	(E) The purchaser of the event ticket is denied admission
9	to the event, unless denial of admission to the event is due to the action or
10	omission of the purchaser of the event ticket.
11	(c)(1) The obligations of a person that offers an event ticket for
12	resale under subdivision (b)(2) of this section shall be posted on the
13	Internet website used to offer an event ticket for resale.
14	(2) A prospective resale purchaser shall be required to
15	acknowledge the posting required by subdivision (c)(1) of this section before
16	agreeing to a resale transaction.
17	(d) A refund issued under subdivision (b)(2) of this section shall
18	include service fees, handling fees, and processing fees unless a service
19	fee, handling fee, or processing fee is declared nonrefundable under the
20	contract between the buyer and seller of an event ticket resale.
21	(e) A person and the website operator of a person that offers an event
22	ticket for resale shall comply with § 4-70-103.
23	(f) Section 5-63-201 does not apply to the resale of an event ticket
24	under this subchapter.
25	(g) This section does not prohibit a person from implementing consumer
26	protection policies that supplement or enhance the requirements of this
27	section.
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29	4-88-904. Enforcement.
30	A violation of this subchapter is:
31	(1) A deceptive and unconscionable trade practice under § 4-88-
32	101 et seq.; and
33	(2) Punishable and enforceable as provided by § 4-88-101 et seq.
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
