19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 21, Chapter 5, Subchapter 1, is amended
20	to add an additional section to read as follows:
21	21-5-110. Filling of vacant positions.
22	(a) As used in this section:
23	(1) "Position" means a single office or employment that:
24	(A) Is legislatively authorized in a state agency; and
25	(B) Requires the services of one (1) full-time equivalent
26	employee; and
27	(2)(A) "State agency" means an agency, authority, department,
28	board, commission, bureau, council, or other agency of the state supported by
29	appropriation of state or federal funds.
30	<u>(B) "State agency" does not include:</u>
31	(i) An institution of higher education;
32	(ii) The following constitutional offices:

8	(b) A state agency shall not fill a position vacant on July 1 of each
9	fiscal year except as provided in this section.
10	(c) A state agency wishing to fill a position vacant on July 1 of each
11	year shall submit a request to the Director of the Department of Finance and
12	Administration for approval.
13	(d)(1) If the director approves the request, he or she shall forward
14	the request to the Legislative Council, or to the Joint Budget Committee if
15	the General Assembly is in session, for review.
16	(2) If the state agency does not fill the vacant position within
17	one hundred twenty (120) days of the review of the Legislative Council or the
18	Joint Budget Committee, the state agency shall resubmit its request to fill
19	the vacant position to the director.
20	<u>(e)(1) A state agency shall report each vacant position on July 1 to</u>
21	the Department of Finance and Administration by August 1 of each year.
22	(2) The Department of Finance and Administration shall submit a
23	report of each vacant position for each state agency to the Legislative
24	Council by September 1 of each year.
