8 AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION PROHIBITING

16 CONSTITUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF AN

27 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
28 STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL
29 MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

32 THAT the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
33 the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
34 for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives
35 and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
36 adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of

SECTION 1. This amendment shall be known and may be cited as "The Arkansas Independent Citizens Commission Amendment of 2014".

SECTION 2. The purpose of this amendment to the Arkansas Constitution is to prohibit members of the General Assembly from establishing their own salaries, to provide for the salaries for the offices of Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General, Secretary of State, Treasurer of State, Commissioner of State Lands, and Auditor of State and for members of the General Assembly as authorized by Section 2 of Amendment 70 of the Arkansas Constitution, and to provide for the creation of an independent citizens commission concerning the salaries of the elected officials of the Executive Department and members of the General Assembly.
