8	TO CELEBRATE ST. PATRICK'S DAY AND TO HONOR THE IRISH
9	CULTURAL SOCIETY OF ARKANSAS FOR ITS CONTRIBUTIONS TO
10	EDUCATING ARKANSANS ABOUT THEIR RICH IRISH CULTURE

15	TO CELEBRATE ST. PATRICK'S DAY AND TO
16	HONOR THE IRISH CULTURAL SOCIETY OF
17	ARKANSAS FOR ITS CONTRIBUTIONS TO
18	EDUCATING ARKANSANS ABOUT THEIR RICH
19	IRISH CULTURE AND HERITAGE.

21	WHEREAS, the Irish Cultural Society of Arkansas is a nonprofit, public
22	service organization founded in 1996 to educate Arkansans in aspects of the
23	culture and history of Ireland; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, the society provides Irish food and objects of Irish art for
26	folk festivals and fairs, provides concerts of Irish music and dance, and
27	participates in community service programs and event, all in an effort to
28	reconnect Arkansans with their Irish heritage; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, the society was originally founded by a group of Irish
31	nationals, many of whom had immigrated to Arkansas during the nursing
32	shortage of the 1980s. Recruited by area hospitals, nurses from Ireland and
33	Great Britain came to Arkansas originally intending to work for a few years
34	and return to their homeland. Instead they married and settled in Little Rock
35	and began to raise families. As their children grew, they realized the
36	importance of passing on their Irish culture and heritage to their American-

3	WHEREAS, the goals of the Irish Cultural Society of Arkansas are to
4	develop and further enhance local interest in the culture of Ireland and its
5	people, to publicize the presence of an active Irish community in the Little
6	Rock area, to reacquaint Arkansans of Irish descent with their culture and
7	ethnic history, and to familiarize the general public with the culture of the
8	Irish people and the richness of their contributions to the United States and
9	the State of Arkansas; and
10	
11	WHEREAS, the society has about eighty (80) members who share a love for
12	and interest in Ireland; and
13	
14	WHEREAS, the society presents an annual St. Patrick's Day Parade in
15	downtown Little Rock and North Little Rock. Before the parade, the society
16	holds an annual festival on or near St. Patrick's Day. As the success of the
17	annual festival has grown, so has the interest in the community-wide parade;
18	and

20	WHEREAS, the 14th Annual St. Patrick's Day Parade will occur on
21	Saturday, March 16, 2013, at 1:00 p.m., and the Irish Cultural Society of
22	Arkansas wishes all Arkansans a very safe and happy St. Patrick's Day,
23	
24	NOW THEREFORE,
25	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
26	STATE OF ARKANSAS:
27	
28	THAT the Senate recognizes and commends the Irish Cultural Society of
29	Arkansas for its contributions to educating Arkansans about their Irish
30	culture and heritage and encourages Arkansans to celebrate St. Patrick's Day
31	not only for its fun and traditional joviality but also for its rich cultural
32	heritage.
