6	millage incentive funding, is amended to read as follows:		
7	(B) The commission shall phase out the state financial		
8	assistance under this subsection over a ten-year period by reducing the		
9	amount received by a school district under this subsection after Fiscal Year		
10	2006 by one-tenth (1/10) in each year of the ten-year period with the savings		
11	distributed through the Educational Facilities Partnership Fund Account in		
12	accordance with rules promulgated by the commission to the Employee Benefits		
13	Division of the Department of Finance and Administration for the exclusive		
14	benefit of public school employees participating in the State and Public		
15	School Life and Health Insurance Program.

17	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
18	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Public School Insurance		
19	Trust Fund is inadequate to provide affordable health insurance for public		
20	school employees; changes to the funding system for public school employee		
21	health insurance is necessary to ensure a stable and affordable program of		
22	health insurance plan options; and that this act is necessary to provide		
23	additional funding for public school employee health insurance. Therefore,		
24	an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being necessary for the		
25	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective		
26	on July 1, 2014.
