10	AN ACT TO REQUIRE EXCESS REVENUE FROM THE UNIFORM
11	RATE OF TAX TO BE CREDITED TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOL FUND;
12	TO PROVIDE STABILITY FOR SCHOOL DISTRICTS THAT
13	RECEIVED EXCESS REVENUE FROM THE UNIFORM RATE OF TAX
14	IN THE 2014-2015 SCHOOL YEAR TO HAVE A GRADUAL PHASE-
15	OUT; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

19	TO REQUIRE EXCESS REVENUE FROM THE
20	UNIFORM RATE OF TAX BE CREDITED TO THE
21	PUBLIC SCHOOL FUND; AND TO DECLARE AN
22	EMERGENCY.

25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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27	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 26-80-101(c), concerning the uniform rate
28	of tax, is amended to read as follows:
29	(c) (1) For Subject to subdivision (c) (2) of this section, for each
30	school year, each county treasurer shall remit the net revenues from the
31	uniform rate of tax to each local school district from which the $\underline{\text{net}}$ revenues
32	were derived.
33	(2)(A) For each local school district, the Department of
34	Education shall determine if the local school district has a net revenue per
35	student from the uniform rate of tax in excess of the per student foundation
36	funding amount under § 6-20-2305.

1	(B) Beginning in the 2015-2016 school year, if the
2	Department of Education determines that a local school district has excess
3	net revenue from the uniform rate of tax as calculated under subdivision
4	(c)(2)(A) of this section then the Department of Education shall certify the
5	amount of excess net revenue from the uniform rate of tax to the affected
6	local school district no later than April 1 each year.
7	(C) A local school district who receives certification
8	under subdivision (c)(2)(B) of this section shall remit the amount certified
9	to the Department of Education for the credit to the Educational Facilities
10	Partnership Fund Account for the maintenance and operation of schools.
11	
12	SECTION 2. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE. DO NOT CODIFY.
13	(a) If a local school district received excess net revenue from the
14	uniform rate of tax as calculated under § 26-80-101(c)(2)(A) for the
15	maintenance and operations of the local school district in the 2014-2015
16	school year, the local school district shall:
17	(1) Retain two-thirds (2/3) of the amount certified by the
18	Department of Education under § 26-80-101(c)(2)(B) for the 2015-2016 school
19	year, if any; and
20	(2) Retain one-third (1/3) of the amount certified by the
21	Department of Education under § 26-80-101(c)(2)(B) for the 2016-2017 school
22	year, if any.
23	(b) A local school district that does not retain excess net revenue
24	under subdivision (a)(1) of this section shall not be entitled to receive
25	excess net revenue under subdivision (a)(2) of this section.
26	
27	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
28	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Public School Insurance
29	Trust Fund is inadequate to provide affordable health insurance for public
30	school employees; changes to the funding system for public school employee
31	health insurance is necessary to ensure a stable and affordable program of
32	health insurance plan options; and that this act is necessary to provide
33	additional funding for public school employee health insurance. Therefore,
34	an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being necessary for the
35	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective
36	on July 1, 2014.
