Members of the preceding General Assembly and the 17 newly elected members of the House of Representatives and Senate shall be 18 eligible to attend the biennial Institute of Legislative Procedure and shall 19 be entitled, upon filing claim therefor, to per diem in the amount fixed by 20 law for members of the General Assembly to receive for attendance at Legislative sessions, for each day in attending the biennial Institute of 21 22 Legislative Procedure plus mileage for traveling from their place of 23 residence to the biennial Institute of Legislative Procedure and return. 24

25 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 26 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 27 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 28 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 29 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 30 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 31 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 32 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 33

34 <u>SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the</u> 35 <u>General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits</u> 36 <u>the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the</u>
