20	SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - CASH. There is hereby appropriated, to		
21	the Northwest Technical Institute, to be payable from the cash funds as		
22	defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801, for the Northwest Technical Institute the

29	SECTION 2. REAP	PROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT.	There is hereby
30	appropriated, to the	appropriated, to the Northwest Technical Institute, to be payable from the	
31	General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the		
32	Northwest Technical I	nstitute the following:	
33	(A) Effective J	uly 1, 2014, the balance of the appr	opriation provided

(B) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 181 of 2013, for transfers of or refunds to expenditures for capital balances for construction, renovation, major maintenance, and purchase of equipment for various capital projects or facility improvements, in a sum not to exceed......\$66,750.

- (D) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) Section 1 of Act 181 of 2013, for construction, renovation, maintenance, major maintenance, improvements, materials, and purchase and maintenance of equipment, in a sum not to exceed......\$10,000.

- (G) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 273 of 2013, for transfers of or refund to expenditures for capital balances for construction, renovation, major maintenance, and purchase of equipment for various capital projects or facility improvements, in a sum not to exceed......\$1,000,000.
- (H) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 641 of 2013, for construction, renovation, maintenance, major maintenance, improvements, materials, and purchase and maintenance of equipment, in a sum not to exceed......\$500,000.

SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and

- 1 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
- 2 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
- 3 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
- 4 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
- 5 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
- 6 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
- 7 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
- 8 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.
- 9 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
- 10 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
- 11 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
- 12 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
- 13 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
- 14 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

35 36 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014.
