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23	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the			
24	Department of Finance and Administration - Division of Racing, to be payable			
25	from the Miscellaneou	is Agencies Fund Account, for personal	services of the

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1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA 2 HELP - DOG RACING. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Finance 3 and Administration - Division of Racing - Dog Racing, for the 2013-2014 4 fiscal year, the maximum number of four (4) part-time or temporary employees, 5 to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such 6 purposes, such employees shall be authorized to work over 1,000 hours per 7 year.

8 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2013 9 through June 30, 2014.

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11 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 12 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 13 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 14 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 15 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 16 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 17 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 18 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 19 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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21 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 22 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 23 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 24 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 25 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 26 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 27 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 28 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 29

30 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of 31 32 the Department of Finance and Administration - Division of Racing are, due to 33 unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Finance and 34 Administration - Division of Racing to continue to provide essential 35 governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the 36 necessary monies for the Department of Finance and Administration - Division

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1	of Racing to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date		
2	of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and		
3	provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is		
4	hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate		
5	preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force		
6	and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.		
7	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall		
8	become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the		
9	Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the		
10	veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house		
11	overrides the veto.		
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
