8 **HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

9 TO PROVIDE FOR A RECESS OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL
10 ASSEMBLY AT THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON MARCH 19, 2014;
11 TO PROVIDE FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE FISCAL SESSION OF
12 THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY UNTIL 12:00 NOON,
13 MARCH 26, 2014; TO AUTHORIZE THE PRESIDENT PRO
14 TEMPORE OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
15 REPRESENTATIVES, BY JOINT PROCLAMATION, TO RECONVENE
16 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT ANY TIME BEFORE 12:00 NOON,
17 MARCH 26, 2014, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING
18 VETOES, CORRECTING ERRORS OR OVERSIGHTS, OR TO
19 ADJOURN THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT ANY TIME
20 BEFORE THAT DATE IF THEY DETERMINE THAT THERE IS NO
21 NEED TO RECONVENE; TO PROVIDE THAT IF THE GENERAL
22 ASSEMBLY IS NOT RECONVENED OR ADJOURNED BEFORE 12:00
23 NOON, MARCH 26, 2014, THE FISCAL SESSION OF THE
24 EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS ADJOURNED SINE DIE
25 ON THAT DATE; AND TO AUTHORIZE ADDITIONAL RECESSES OF
26 EITHER OR BOTH CHAMBERS FOR PERIODS OF FOUR (4)
27 CONSECUTIVE DAYS OR LONGER.

31 TO PROVIDE FOR AN EXTENSION AND SINE DIE
32 ADJOURNMENT OF THE FISCAL SESSION OF THE
33 EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND TO
34 PROVIDE FOR RECESSES OF THE HOUSE OF
35 REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL
3 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

5 (a) That the Fiscal Session of the Eighty-Ninth General Assembly of
6 the State of Arkansas is extended until 12:00 noon, March 26, 2014;

7 (b) That the Fiscal Session of the Eighty-Ninth General Assembly of
8 the State of Arkansas shall enter into recess at the close of business in
9 each chamber on March 19, 2014, or at an earlier time as may be agreed upon
10 by the House of Representatives and the Senate;

11 (c) That under Arkansas Constitution, Article 6, § 15, before
12 adjournment of the General Assembly, the Governor is afforded five (5) days
13 after receipt of a bill to sign a bill or veto a bill; therefore, from
14 March 19, 2014, to March 26, 2014, the House of Representatives and the
15 Senate shall be open so that the office of the Chief Clerk of the House of
16 Representatives and the office of the Secretary of the Senate may receive
17 communications, vetoes of bills by the Governor, and notification of errors
18 and oversights;

19 (d) That the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President
20 Pro Tempore of the Senate may, by joint proclamation:

21 (1) Reconvene the General Assembly at any time before 12:00
22 noon, March 26, 2014, for the purpose of:

23 (A) Considering vetoes; or

24 (B) Correcting errors and oversights; or

25 (2) Adjourn the Fiscal Session of the Eighty-Ninth General
26 Assembly at any time before 12:00 noon, March 26, 2014, if they determine it
27 is not necessary to reconvene;

28 (e) That if the General Assembly is not reconvened or adjourned before
29 12:00 noon, March 26, 2014, the Fiscal Session of the Eighty-Ninth General
30 Assembly is adjourned sine die on that date; and

31 (f) That during the Fiscal Session, in addition to the recess provided
32 for in subdivision (b), the:

33 (1) House of Representatives may recess for periods of four (4)
34 consecutive days or longer, by declaration of the Speaker of the House of
35 Representatives; and

36 (2) Senate may recess for periods of four (4) consecutive days

1 or longer, by declaration of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.
