 PROVISION - FOREIGN OFFICES. If at any time during the fiscal year, the

Director determines that market conditions warrant, the Arkansas Economic Development Commission is hereby authorized to transfer appropriation, after receiving the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, between the Foreign Offices in the State Operations Section of this Act for the purpose of responding to changes in the world markets.

7 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 8 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 9 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 10 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 11 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 12 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 13 has determined that the Arkansas Economic Development Commission may operate 14 more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Arkansas Economic 15 Development Commission authorizing broad powers under this Section. 16 Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly 17 maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or 18 Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. SECTION 25. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 3 4 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING 5 TRANSFER. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may transfer from time to 6 time on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum not to exceed thirty million dollars (\$30,000,000) from 7 8 Federal Funds as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to the 9 Technology Acceleration Fund to provide funds for the appropriation herein. 10

11 SECTION 26. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 12 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 13 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 14 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 15 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 16 17 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 18 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 19 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 27. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 21 22 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 23 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 24 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 25 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 26 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 27 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 28 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 29

30 <u>SECTION 28. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the</u> 31 <u>General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits</u> 32 <u>the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the</u> 33 <u>effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of</u> 34 <u>the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in</u> 35 <u>the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the</u> 36 <u>effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm</u>
