AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES
AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS
AND TOURISM - ARKANSAS HISTORY COMMISSION FOR THE
FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2015; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND
TOURISM - ARKANSAS HISTORY COMMISSION
APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2014-2015 FISCAL
YEAR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - HISTORY COMMISSION. There is hereby
established for the Department of Parks and Tourism - Arkansas History
Commission for the 2014-2015 fiscal year, the following maximum number of
regular employees.

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9 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - HISTORY COMMISSION. There is hereby
 10 authorized, for the Department of Parks and Tourism - Arkansas History
 11 Commission for the 2014-2015 fiscal year, the following maximum number of
 12 part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from
 13 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: three (3) temporary or part-
 14 time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in
 15 the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this
 16 act for the appropriate classification.

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18 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - HISTORY COMMISSION - STATE. There is hereby
 19 appropriated, to the Department of Parks and Tourism - Arkansas History
 20 Commission, to be payable from the Parks and Tourism Fund Account, for
 21 personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Parks and
 22 Tourism - Arkansas History Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30,
 23 2015, the following:

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3 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - HISTORY COMMISSION - CASH. There is hereby
4 appropriated, to the Department of Parks and Tourism - Arkansas History
5 Commission, to be payable from the cash fund deposited in the State Treasury
6 as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for operating
7 expenses of the Department of Parks and Tourism - Arkansas History Commission
8 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, the following:

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20 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
21 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
22 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
23 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
24 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
25 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
26 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
27 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
28 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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30 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
31 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
32 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
33 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
34 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
35 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
36 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

1 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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3 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
4 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
5 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
6 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of
7 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
8 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
9 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm
10 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
11 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
12 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
13 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014.
