- 5 Services, Developmental Disabilities Services.
- 6 3. Establish and maintain a sound financial management system in accordance
- 7 with guidelines as set forth by the Department of Human Services.
- 8 4. Establish and maintain community support programs designed to provide
- 9 coordinated care and treatment to ensure ongoing involvement and
- 10 individualized services for persons with disabilities. Every community
- ll support program shall provide services for persons with disabilities who
- 12 reside within the respective area of the program.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2013
- 14 <u>2014</u> through June 30, 2014 <u>2015</u>.

- 16 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 18 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES TIMBER SALES PROCEEDS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND
- 19 EQUIPMENT. The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services is authorized
- 20 to use the administrative operating accounts for capital improvements to
- 21 physical plants and for the purchase of capital equipment. The funds shall be
- 22 held by the Department of Human Services, Division of Developmental
- 23 Disabilities Services from the proceeds of the sale of timber that may be
- 24 harvested from land owned by the Division of Developmental Disabilities
- 25 Services. All funds deposited and all expenses shall be tracked separately.
- 26 The harvesting of timber is specifically authorized to provide funds to
- 27 finance capital improvements to the physical plants and for the purchase of
- 28 major capital equipment.
- 29 The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services shall report all
- 30 income derived from timber management to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
- 31 State and the Arkansas Legislative Council. Any contracts initiated for the
- 32 harvesting of timber shall be submitted to the Review Subcommittee of the
- 33 Arkansas Legislative Council for prior review. All expenditures of funds
- 34 derived from the sale of timber will be expended in accordance with relevant
- 35 state purchasing laws.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2013

1 2014 through June 30, 2014 2015.

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SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HUMAN DEVELOPMENT CENTERS AND COMMUNITY PROVIDERS.

- 6 (A) The Developmental Disabilities Services Board or the Department of
 7 Human Services shall not close any of the state administered Human
 8 Development Centers which are located at Conway, Arkadelphia, Jonesboro,
 9 Booneville, and Warren.
- 10 (B) The Department of Human Services shall continue to accept clients for
 11 whom it has determined that therapy and residential services are needed at
 12 state administered Human Development Centers and Community Programs licensed
 13 by DDS shall continue to accept clients for whom it has been determined in
 14 accordance with federal law that are in need of services in the community.
- (C) Except for use as federal matching funds, no funds for community based services licensed by DDS shall be transferred from Grants to Community
 Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities Services Grants-inAid appropriation unless the transfer(s) directly benefit(s) community based services for persons with developmental disabilities or from the appropriation for the Human Development Centers unless the transfer(s) directly benefit(s) the Human Development Centers.
- 22 (D) Nor shall any general revenue funding as of July 1, 2013 2014 from the 23 Grants to Community Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities 24 Services - Grants-in-Aid appropriation for persons with developmental 25 disabilities or from any other general revenues as of July 1, 2013 2014, 26 applied as federal matching funds for community based services licensed by 27 DDS on July 1, 2013 2014 be reduced below the approved funding level on July 28 1, 2013 2014; nor shall the general revenues applied as federal matching 29 funds for the Human Development Centers be reduced below the approved funding 30 level on July 1, 2013 2014.

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SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AUTISM TREATMENT AND COORDINATION. The Department of Human Services - Division of Developmental Disabilities Services shall promulgate rules and regulations regarding the licensure and oversight of Applied Behavior Analysts as

1 described in Arkansas Code § 23-99-418. The rules and regulations shall 2 include a requirement for a licensure application fee equal to that charged 3 to applicants to be licensed as a psychologist as described in Arkansas Code 4 § 17-97-309. Proceeds from this fee are declared as cash funds. 5 6 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE 7 ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL, AND TEMPORARY LAW. 8 EARLY INTERVENTION DAY TREATMENT. 9 (a)(1) Until the requirement in subsection (b) has been met, the 10 Department of Human Services, including without limitation the Division of 11 Developmental Disabilities Services and the Division of Medical Services, 12 shall not enter any arrangement, contract for any services, commit any funds, 13 make any fund transfers, interagency or otherwise, or allocate any resources by any means to support the screening, assessment, evaluation, or treatment 14 15 of the early intervention day treatment needs of a Medicaid-eligible child 16 from birth to age five (5) by an academic medical center or any third party 17 contractor. 18 (2) As used in this section, "early intervention day treatment" 19 has the same meaning as defined in Arkansas Code § 20-48-1102(5). 20 (b) The House Committee on Public Health, Welfare and Labor, Senate Committee on Public Health, Welfare and Labor and the Administrative Rules 21 22 and Regulations Subcommittee of the Legislative Council shall review the 23 proposed arrangement, contract, fund commitment, fund transfer, or resource allocation and all materials related to the development and implementation 24 25 plans of the proposed arrangement, contract, fund commitment, fund transfer, or resource allocation, including without limitation data and cost-benefit 26 27 analysis justifying the cost. 28 (c) Implementation of the new early intervention day treatment program shall begin at the later of: 29 30 (1) Ninety (90) days after the publication of proposed program 31 rates; or 32 (2) January 1, 2015. 33 SECTION 19. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 34 35 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

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1 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 2 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 3 4 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 5 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 6 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 7 8 SECTION 20. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 10 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 11 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 16 17 SECTION 21. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 18 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 19 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 20 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of 21 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 22 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 23 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm 24 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 25 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 26 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014. 27 28 29 /s/Joint Budget Committee 30 31 32 33 34 35
