21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:			
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23	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the			
24	Department of Education, to be payable from the Department of Education			
25	Public School Fund Account, for grants and aid to local school districts and			
26	special programs of the Department of Education which shall be supplemental			
27	and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 1 of Act 1309 of 2013,

34	SECTION 2. COMP	SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds		
35	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency			
36	and funds made availa	hle by law for the support of suc	th appropriations, and	

- 1 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 2 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 3 4 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 5 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 6 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 7 8 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 10 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 11 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 16 17 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 18 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of 19 the Department of Education are, due to unforeseen circumstances, 20 insufficient for the Department of Education to continue to provide essential 21 governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the 22 necessary monies for the Department of Education to continue such services;
- 20 insufficient for the Department of Education to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the
 22 necessary monies for the Department of Education to continue such services;
 23 and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable
 24 harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
 25 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
 26 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
 27 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its
 28 passage and approval.
 - If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.

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
