1	FACILITIES MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM - MATCHING FUNDS. The funds appropriated
2	for state match for the Broadband Facilities Matching Grant Program in this
3	Act shall be paid on a one-to-one state/local matching basis.
4	The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
5	2013 through June 30, 2014.

7	SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
8	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
9	TRANSFER - BROADBAND FACILITIES MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM. Immediately upon the
10	effective date of this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall
11	transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor
12	of the State the sum of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) from the

34	written request set forth in item (1) above;

1 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written 2 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for 3 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30) 4 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents 5 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget 6 Committee; and 7 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall 8 include all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals 9 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or 10 Institution. 11 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 12 2013 through June 30, 2014. 13 14 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 15 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 16 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 17 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 18 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 19 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 20 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 21 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 22 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 23 24 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 25 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 26 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 27 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 28 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 29 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 30 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 31 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 32 33 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. 1	Fund to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the
2	provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Department

4	in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper

6	an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
7	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
8	full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
9	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall
