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20	SECTION 1. REAP	PROPRIATION - U OF A - FORT SMITH.	There is hereby
21	appropriated, to the University of Arkansas - Fort Smith, to be payable from		
22	the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the

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31	SECTION 2. SPEC	IAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORA	TED INTO THE ARKANSAS
32	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. As		
33	referenced in Section 1(A) of Act 820 of 2013, Section 3(c) of Act 1518 of		
34	2013 and Section 3(c) of Act 1519 of 2013, the authorized funding for the		
35	University of Arkansa	s - Fort Smith for design developm	ent, construction,
36	land acquisition, equ	ipment, renovation, and operating	expenses for the

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1 Mallalieu Center for Academic Excellence shall be deemed to also include construction, land acquisition, equipment, renovation, personal services and 2 3 operating expenses. 4 5 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Uncodified Item (H) of Section 23 of Act 6 34 of 2014, concerning Reappropriations to Institutions of Higher Education, 7 is amended to read as follows: 8 (H) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided 9 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 820 of 2013, for design development, 10 construction, land acquisition, equipment, renovation, and operating expenses 11 for the Mallalieu Center for Academic Excellence, in a sum not to exceed 12 13 14 SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor 15 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects 16 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available 17 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and 18 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and 19 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or 20 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State 21 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects 22 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds 23 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General 24 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall 25 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act. (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing 26 27 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue 28 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State 29 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any 30 31 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law. 32 33 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 34 35 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for

which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

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1	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget		
2	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or		
3	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative		
4	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.		
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6	SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General		
7	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the		
8	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the		
9	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of		
10	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in		
11	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the		
12	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm		
13	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental		
14	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act		
15	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health		
16	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014.
