13 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
14 SERVICES REAPPROPRIATION.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - GENERAL
21 IMPROVEMENT FUND. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human
22 Services, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor
23 fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Human Services the following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 164 of 2013, for a grant to an organization for
26 training, job readiness, and adult literacy services of former prisoners to
27 be re-introduced into society, in a sum not to exceed.....\$3,750.

28 (B) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
29 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 164 of 2013, for a grant to an organization for
30 youth summer employment programs for tutoring, mentoring, educational,
31 social, recreational, personal services and operating expenses, in a sum not
32 to exceed.....\$3,750.

33 (C) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
34 in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 164 of 2013, for grants for operating expenses,
35 equipment, maintenance and construction for Health Clinics, in a sum not to
36 exceed.....\$25,857.



1 (D) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
2 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 661 of 2013, for grants for hunger relief
3 service providers for operating expenses, construction, renovation,
4 improvements, maintenance, and the purchase of equipment, food, and supplies,

12 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 698 of 2013, for grants for personal services,
13 operating expenses and equipment for a food pantry, in a sum not to exceed
14\$25,000.

15 (G) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
16 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 699 of 2013, for grants for operating expenses,
17 treatment programs and equipment for homeless shelters, in a sum not to
18 exceed.....\$75,000.

19 (H) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
20 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 801 of 2013, for grants to community
21 organizations for personal services, operating expenses and the purchase of
22 equipment and supplies to alleviate hunger through food distribution and
23 education, in a sum not to exceed.....\$100,000.

24 (I) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 801 of 2013, for grants to Arkansas Hunters
26 Feeding the Hungry for personal services, operating expenses and the purchase
27 of equipment and supplies, in a sum not to exceed.....\$500,000.

28 (J) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
29 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 809 of 2013, for grants for domestic violence
30 shelters for personal services, operating expenses, construction,
31 improvements, equipment, renovation and maintenance expenses to provide
32 crisis intervention, safe shelter, social/legal advocacy and support
33 services, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,000,000.

34 (K) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
35 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 815 of 2013, for grants for homeless shelters
36 for personal services, operating expenses, construction, improvements,

1 equipment, renovation and maintenance expenses to provide crisis
2 intervention, safe shelter, social/legal advocacy and support services, in a
3 sum not to exceed.....\$1,000,000.

4 (L) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
5 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 842 of 2013, for grants for community based
6 programs for personal services, operating expenses, equipment, supplies and
7 maintenance expenses, in a sum not to exceed.....\$250,000.

8 (M) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
9 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 850 of 2013, for grants for equipment,
10 maintenance, operations, construction, landscaping and personal services for
11 facilities and parks for special needs children and adults to safely
12 participate in sports, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,000,000.

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14 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - DIRECTOR'S OFFICE - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT
15 FUND. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services -
16 Director's Office, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
17 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Human Services -
18 Director's Office the following:

19 (A) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
20 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 925 of 2013, for a planning and assessment grant
21 for personal services, operating expenses, construction, improvements,
22 equipment, renovation and maintenance expenses for the Child Maltreatment
23 Central Registry and the Adult and Long-Term Care Facility Resident
24 Maltreatment Central Registry, in a sum not to exceed.....\$89,000.

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26 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES -
27 GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUND. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of
28 Human Services - Division of Administrative Services, to be payable from the
29 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
30 Department of Human Services - Division of Administrative Services the
31 following:

32 (A) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
33 in Item (A) Section 2 of Act 164 of 2013, for various maintenance,
34 renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and
35 repair projects for all state-owned real property and facilities department-
36 wide, in a sum not to exceed.....\$98,623.

1 (B) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
2 in Item (B) Section 2 of Act 164 of 2013, for grants and assistance to
3 community organizations for maintenance and general operations, personal
4 services, and construction expenses, in a sum not to exceed.....\$500.

5 (C) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
6 in Item (C) Section 2 of Act 164 of 2013, for various maintenance,
7 renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade and
8 repair of real property and facilities department-wide, in a sum not to
9 exceed.....\$80,000.

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11 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF COMMUNITY SERVICE AND

14 Nonprofit Support, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
15 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Human Services -
16 Division of Community Service and Nonprofit Support the following:

17 (A) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
18 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 339 of 2013, for a grant for a statewide
19 membership-based nonprofit association for continued development to promote
20 and support statewide capacity building and nonprofit workforce development
21 through technical assistance for organizational development, products and
22 services to improve efficiency, and a network for professional and
23 organizational engagement, in a sum not to exceed.....\$125,000.

24 (B) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 667 of 2013, for grants to Community
26 Organizations which provide services to the poor for construction,
27 renovation, personal services and operating expenses, purchase of equipment,
28 and major maintenance, in a sum not to exceed.....\$400,000.

2 renovation, personal services and operating expenses, purchase of equipment,
3 and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a sum not to exceed
4\$250,000.

5 (B) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
6 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 397 of 2013, for grants to Area Agencies on
7 Aging for construction, renovation, major maintenance, maintenance and
8 purchase of equipment, in a sum not to exceed.....\$500,000.

32 and Enrollment Framework System for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance
33 Program (SNAP), computer equipment and software licenses, in a sum not to
34 exceed.....\$1,690,750.
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36 SECTION 13. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor

1 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
2 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
3 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
4 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
5 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
6 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
7 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
8 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
9 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
10 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
11 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

12 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
13 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
14 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
15 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
16 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
17 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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19 SECTION 14. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
20 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
21 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
22 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
23 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
24 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
25 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
26 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

28 SECTION 15. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
29 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
30 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
31 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of
32 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
33 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
34 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm
35 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
36 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act

1 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
2 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014.

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
