SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 10 11 TRANSFER. To provide funding for the appropriations authorized herein, the 12 Director of the Assessment Coordination Department of the State of Arkansas 13 shall certify monthly to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the amount of 14 funding needed each month to pay counties and professional reappraisal 15 companies for the reappraisal of real property as required by law. Upon 16 receipt of such certification the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall 17 transfer on his books and those of the State Treasurer 76% of the amounts 18 certified from the Department of Education Public School Fund Account, 16% of 19 the amount certified from the County Aid Fund, and 8% of the amount certified 20 from the Municipal Aid Fund to the Arkansas Real Property Reappraisal Fund. 21 In no event shall the total amount of funds transferred as authorized herein 22 exceed fourteen million two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$14,250,000) in a 23 single fiscal year. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, -201224 25 2014 through June 30, 2013 2015. 26 27 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PARCELS. 28 29 The Assessment Coordination Department shall reimburse counties and professional reappraisal companies monthly up to the maximum cost per parcel, 30 31 multiplied by the total number of parcels in the county, divided by the 32 number of months in a county's reappraisal cycle. The term parcel as used herein shall be defined by department rule, and department reimbursements 33 34 based upon only the total number of parcels determined to qualify under 35 department rule.

NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 3 4 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 5 ANNUAL FUNDING FOR REAPPRAISALS/REVIEWS. Whether a county's reappraisal of 6 real property is simply a review of existing data, or a more extensive 7 reappraisal where every improvement is measured, funding to any county, 8 provided through the Assessment Coordination Department, will be for the 9 actual appraisal cost, up to a maximum of seven dollars per parcel, per year. 10 Counties must use other taxing unit sources of revenue to provide for the 11 cost of real property reappraisals if the cost to complete the reappraisal 12 exceeds seven dollars per parcel. 13 14 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 16 TRANSFERS. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 17 State, the Director of the Assessment Coordination Department is authorized 18 to transfer funds during the 2012-2013 2014-2015 fiscal year from the 19 Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account designated for support of the Assessment 20 Coordination Department to the Real Property Reappraisal Fund. The total of 21 all transfers shall not exceed \$1,500,000. 22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July $1, \frac{2012}{}$ 23 2014 through June 30, 2013 2015. 24 25 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 27 PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 28 State, the Director of the Assessment Coordination Department is authorized 29 to transfer appropriation from the Operating Expenses line item in the State 30 Operations Program to the Assessor's School special line item to assure 31 sufficient resources are available to provide required training for 32 assessment personnel. 33 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,-2013

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2014 through June 30, 2014 2015.

SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

1	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
2	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
3	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
4	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
5	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
6	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
7	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
8	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
9	
10	SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
11	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
12	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
13	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
14	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
15	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
16	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
17	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
18	
19	SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
20	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
21	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
22	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of
23	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
24	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
25	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm
26	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
27	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
28	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
29	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014.
