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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
24 for the University of Arkansas Community College at Batesville for the 2014-
25 2015 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

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32 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for
 33 the University of Arkansas Community College at Batesville for the 2014-2015
 34 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary
 35 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated
 36 herein for such purposes: one hundred (100) temporary or part-time

1 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the
 2 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act
 3 for the appropriate classification.

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 5 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby
 6 appropriated, to the University of Arkansas Community College at Batesville,
 7 to be payable from the University of Arkansas Community College at Batesville
 8 Fund, for personal services of the University of Arkansas Community College
 9 at Batesville for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, the following:

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 18 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,
 19 to the University of Arkansas Community College at Batesville, to be payable
 20 from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the University of
 21 Arkansas Community College at Batesville, for personal services and operating
 22 expenses of the University of Arkansas Community College at Batesville for
 23 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, the following:

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8 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

9 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

10 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

11 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

13 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures

14 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this

15 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of

16 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied

17 with in disbursement of said funds.

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19 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

20 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

21 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for

22 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

23 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

24 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

25 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

26 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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28 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

29 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

30 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the

31 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of

32 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

33 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the

34 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm

35 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental

36 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act

1 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
2 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014.

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
