2	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
3	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the expansion of the lottery		
4	to include multidraw screen-based lottery games goes beyond the intent of the		
5	constitutional amendment; that voters did not anticipate such multidraw		
6	screen-based lottery games to be used as a part of the scholarship lottery		
7	program; and that this act is immediately necessary to prohibit the		
8	implementation of multidraw screen-based lottery games and to ensure the		
9	integrity of the lottery as envisioned by Arkansas citizens. Therefore, an		
10	emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for		
11	the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become		
12	<pre>effective on:</pre>		
13	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
14	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
15	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
16	bill; or		
17	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
18	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
