13	TO CLARIFY ARKANSAS LAWS CONCERNING
14	CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT.
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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-11-801(d), concerning the definitions
20	used for procurement of professional services, is amended to read as follows:
21	(d)(1) As used in this section, "construction management" means a
22	project delivery method based on an agreement in which a state agency,
23	political subdivision, public school district, or institution of higher
24	education acquires from a construction entity manager a series of
25	<u>professional</u> services that include , but are not limited to, <u>without</u>
26	<u>limitation:</u>
27	(A) design Design review;
28 29	(B) seheduling Scheduling;
30	(C) cost Cost control;
31	<u>(D)</u>
32	(F) preparation Preparation and coordination of bid
33	packages for all trade contracts and purchase orders; and
34	(G) construction Construction administration.
35	(2) "Construction As used in this section, "construction
36	management" includes, but is not limited to without limitation:

1	(A)(i) "Agency construction management", in which a public
2	school district selects a construction manager to serve as an agent for the
3	purpose of providing to provide administration and management services.
4	(ii) The construction manager shall not hold
5	subcontracts trade contracts or purchase orders for the project or provide
6	project bonding for the project;
7	(B)(i) "At-risk construction management", in which the
8	construction entity, after providing manager provides agency services during
9	the preconstruction period, and serves as the general contractor and the
10	following conditions are met:
11	(i)(ii) The construction manager shall:
12	<u>(a)</u> provides Provide a maximum guaranteed
13	maximum price for work performed as the general contractor; and
14	(b) Bond and guarantee the part of the project
15	not covered by the trade contracts, vendor contracts, and purchase orders;.
16	(ii) The public school district holds all trade
17	contracts and purchase orders; and
18	(iii) The portion of the project not covered by the
19	trade contracts is bonded and guaranteed by the construction manager; and
20	(iii) The public school district shall hold all
21	trade contracts and purchase orders; and
22	(C)(i) "General contractor construction management", in
23	which the construction entity manager, after providing agency services during
24	the preconstruction period, serves as the general contractor.
25	(ii) The general contractor construction manager
26	<u>shall:</u>
27	(a) Provide a guaranteed maximum price;
28	$\underline{(b)}$ \underline{shall} \underline{hold} \underline{all} $trade$ $contracts$ and
29	purchase orders; and
30	$\underline{(c)}$ shall bond \underline{Bond} and guarantee the project.
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32	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 19-11-801(e), concerning the definitions
33	used for procurement of professional services, is amended to add an
34	additional subdivision to read as follows:
35	(3) "Bid package" means a defined scope of trade work as
36	determined by the construction manager to receive bids from trade contractors

1	and vendors.
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3	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 19-11-801, concerning the competitive
4	bidding practices used for procurement of professional services, is amended
5	to add additional subsections to read as follows:
6	(f) A construction manager shall:
7	(1) Comply with this section for the solicitation and submission
8	of all bid packages regardless of the type of construction management
9	services;
10	(2)(A) Secure at least three (3) bids on all bid packages for
11	trade work and vendor contracts or purchase orders under the applicable
12	procurement laws.
13	(B)(i) If the construction manager is unable to obtain a
14	minimum of three (3) bids on all bid packages for trade work and vendor
15	contracts or purchase orders, the construction manager shall document its
16	efforts and submit the written documentation to the owner.
17	(ii) The owner may waive the requirement of a
18	minimum of three (3) bids;
19	(3) Prepare and present a tabulated form to the owner that
20	accurately represents the range of bids for each bid package for trade work
21	and vendor contracts or purchase orders; and
22	(4)(A) Be present when the sealed bids are opened for each bid
23	package for trade work and vendor contracts or purchase orders.
24	(B) An owner or the owner's representative may be present
25	when the sealed bids are opened under subdivision (f)(4)(A) of this section.
26	(g) A construction manager may perform work for a bid package for
27	trade work if the construction manager submits a sealed bid in the same
28	manner as a trade contractor.
29	(h) An owner has the right to approve or disapprove:
30	(1) A list of trade contractors submitted by the construction
31	manager for the project before the solicitation of sealed bids; and
32	(2) Any trade contractor or vendor before a final decision is
33	made to award a trade contract, vendor contract, or a purchase order.
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35	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 19-11-802(d)(1), concerning public school
36	districts' use of construction management services, is amended to read as

1	follows:
2	(d)(1) A public school district that utilizes construction management
3	services shall:
4	(A)(i) encourage Annually publish a public notice of its
5	intention to receive written requests for qualifications for professional
6	construction management firms to submit to services or may request such
7	information as needed for a particular public project.
8	(ii) The notice under subdivision (d)(l)(A)(i) of this section shall
9	be published for three (3) consecutive days in a newspaper of local
10	distribution.
11	(iii) The public school district shall allow a
12	minimum of ten (10) working days from the first date of publication of the
13	notice under subdivision $(d)(1)(A)(i)$ of this section for the professional
14	firms to send letters of interest or resumes in response to the newspaper
15	advertisement; and
16	(B) Provide additional means of notification, if
17	appropriate, as determined by the public school district annual statements of
18	qualifications and performance data or may request such information as needed
19	for a particular public project .
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21	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 19-11-805(b)(1)(B), concerning the
22	procedure to select a firm if negotiations are unsuccessful with the initial
23	firm selected, is amended to read as follows:
24	(B) The state agency or political subdivision shall then
25	undertake negotiations negotiate with another of the second qualified firms
26	<u>firm</u> selected.
