occurring on the commission after August 1, 1985, shall be filled by the 1 2 Governor in such manner so that at least five (5) of the members of the 3 commission shall be are owners or operators of food service, lodging, or 4 travel-oriented businesses. 5 (ii) A travel-oriented business includes, but is not 6 limited to, without limitation boat docks, marinas, theme parks, camp 7 grounds, tourist resorts, caves, caverns, highway gift shops, and firms 8 commonly known as tourist attractions. 9 (iii) The Governor also shall assure that at least 10 one (1) of the members of the commission is active in the news media in this 11 state. 12 (iv) Subdivisions (a)(1)(B)(i)-(iii) of this section 13 shall do not cut short the term of any member of the commission serving as 14 such on August 1, 1985, but shall be implemented by the filling of vacancies; 15 (2) One (1) member who is sixty (60) years of age or over, who 16 shall serve as a representative of the elderly and who shall is not be 17 actively engaged in or retired from any of the professions set out in under subdivision (a)(l)(A) of this section; and 18 19 (3) One (1) or more commissioner emeritus commissioners emeriti 20 if designated under § 15-11-203. 21 22 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 15-11-203 is amended to read as follows: 23 15-11-203. Commissioner emeritus. 24 (a) Any A person who has shall be known and designated as a 25 "commissioner emeritus" if he or she: 26 (1) Has served, is now serving, or serves in the future for at 27 least twenty-four (24) years as a member for of the State Parks, Recreation, 28 and Travel Commission, as established by §§ 15-11-201, 15-11-202, and 15-11-29 204 - 15-11-207, or its predecessor commissions and who has served or serves twenty-four (24) years as a member of the commission or its predecessor 30 31 commissions shall be known and designated as a "commissioner emeritus".; and 32 (2) Was known and designated as a "commissioner emeritus" under 33 this section on or before the effective date of this act. (b) A commissioner emeritus shall serve as a member of the commission 34 35 for the remainder of his or her life and, shall be notified of all commission

meetings, and is entitled to the same expenses and other allowances for

3	(c) The Governor shall cause an appropriate commission to be prepared		
4	and issued to each commissioner emeritus of the commission. The commissioner		
5	emeritus shall file the commission with the Secretary of State and take the		
6	official oath of office before entering upon his or her duties as a		
7	commissioner emeritus.
