4	18-40-111. Duty to provide satisfaction of mortgage for recording.		
5	(a) A duty to provide a document for recording evidencing satisfaction		
6	of a mortgage rests with the party recorded as the mortgage holder.		
7	(b) The duty may be satisfied by providing a recordable instrument:		
8	(1) Signed and acknowledged by the mortgage holder;		
9	(2) Signed and acknowledged by a party recorded as the servicer
