14 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS WATERWAYS
15 COMMISSION APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2015-
16 2016 FISCAL YEAR.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
23 Arkansas Waterways Commission for the 2015-2016 fiscal year, the following
24 maximum number of regular employees.

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35 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
36 to the Arkansas Waterways Commission, to be payable from the Miscellaneous



1 Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the
 2 Arkansas Waterways Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the

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18 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - WATERWAY DEVELOPMENT GRANT PROGRAM. There
 19 is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Waterways Commission, to be payable
 20 from the Arkansas Port, Intermodal, and Waterway Development Grant Program
 21 Fund, for grants to port authorities and intermodal authorities under the
 22 Arkansas Port, Intermodal, and Waterway Development Grant Program for port
 23 development projects as defined by Arkansas Code § 15-23-205 for the fiscal
 24 year ending June 30, 2016, the following:

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30 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - THREE RIVERS STUDY. There is hereby
 31 appropriated, to the Arkansas Waterways Commission, to be payable from the
 32 cash fund deposited in the State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal
 33 Officer of the State, for personal services, operating expenses,
 34 construction, and project expenses for the "Three Rivers Study" of the area
 35 at the confluence of the Arkansas, Mississippi, and White Rivers for the
 36 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the sum of.....\$1,500,000.

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2 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
4 ASSOCIATION DUES. Of the amounts appropriated for regional contributions by
5 item (04) in Section 2 of this Act, three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00), or
6 three-sevenths (3/7) whichever is less of the appropriated or funded amount,
7 each fiscal year shall be allocated for membership dues for the Lower
8 Mississippi Valley Flood Control Association and one thousand dollars
9 (\$1,000.00), or one-seventh (1/7) whichever is less of the appropriated or
10 funded amount, each fiscal year shall be allocated for membership dues for
11 each of the following associations: Ouachita River Valley Association, Red
12 River Valley Association, Arkansas Basin Association, and White River Valley
13 Coalition.

14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~
15 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

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17 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
18 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
19 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
20 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
21 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
22 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
23 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
24 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
25 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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27 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
28 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
29 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
30 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
31 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
32 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
33 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
34 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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36 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

1 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
2 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
3 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of
4 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
5 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
6 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm
7 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
8 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
9 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
10 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
