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12 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 13 14 ADDITIONAL TEACHING LOAD. Instructional staff at Northwest Technical 15 Institute, may be paid up to fifty dollars (\$50) per clock hour for the 16 fiscal year ending June 30, 2015 2016, for noncredit teaching assignments; or 17 up to five hundred fifty dollars (\$550) per semester hour for the fiscal year 18 ending June 30, 2015 2016, for teaching courses beyond the defined teaching 19 load; and the employee's maximum allowable salary may be exceeded by such 20 amount; provided, however, that such additional teaching load may not exceed 21 one hundred fifty (150) clock hours or nine (9) semester credit hours per 22 school year. Further, the provisions of this section shall only apply to 23 credit and noncredit courses that are funded by Private Industry. 24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, -201425 2015 through June 30, 2015 2016.

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27 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 28 EXTRA 29 HELP RESTRICTION. No employee at Northwest Technical Institute, who is employed as "Extra Help" may exceed eighty-five percent (85%) of the maximum 30 31 annual salary for a comparable position as authorized under Arkansas Code 21-32 5-201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor shall such employee be employed for 33 a period of time to exceed fourteen hundred (1400) hours in any single fiscal 34 year.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2014
<u>2015</u> through June 30, 2015 <u>2016</u>.

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2 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 3 4 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 5 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 6 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 7 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 8 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 9 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 10 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 12 13 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 14 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 15 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 16 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 17 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 18 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 19 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 20

SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 21 22 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 23 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 24 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of 25 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 26 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm 27 28 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 29 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 30 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015. 31 32 33 34

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
