15 FINANCE AUTHORITY APPROPRIATION FOR THE
16 2015-2016 FISCAL YEAR.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
23 Arkansas Development Finance Authority for the 2015-2016 fiscal year, the
24 following maximum number of regular employees.

13 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas
 14 Development Finance Authority for the 2015-2016 fiscal year, the following
 15 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra
 16 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5)
 17 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed
 18 those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its
 19 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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21 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
 22 to the Arkansas Development Finance Authority, to be payable from cash funds
 23 as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas Development Finance
 24 Authority, for personal services, operating expenses, data processing
 25 services and grants and aid by the Arkansas Development Finance Authority for
 26 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the following:

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10 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS HOUSING TRUST FUND ADVISORY
 11 COMMITTEE. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Development Finance
 12 Authority, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801
 13 of the Arkansas Development Finance Authority, for personal services and
 14 operating expenses of the Arkansas Development Finance Authority - Arkansas
 15 Housing Trust Fund Advisory Committee for the fiscal year ending June 30,
 16 2016, the following:

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23 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HUD HOME
 25 PROGRAM DISBURSEMENTS. The disbursement of funds appropriated in the HUD Home
 26 Program of this Act shall be in accordance with the State of Arkansas
 27 Consolidated Plan developed and administered in part by the Arkansas
 28 Development Finance Authority and shall be in accordance with project
 29 requirements and regulations of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban
 30 Development HOME Program.

31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~
 32 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

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34 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 35 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 36 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

1 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
2 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
3 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
4 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
5 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
6 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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8 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
10 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
11 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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17 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
18 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
19 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
20 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of
21 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
22 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
23 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm
24 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
25 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
26 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
27 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
