12	HANDGUN IN A UNIVERSITY, COLLEGE, OR COMMUNITY
13	COLLEGE BUILDING; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

17	CONCERNING THE POSSESSION OF A CONCEALED
18	HANDGUN IN A UNIVERSITY, COLLEGE, OR
19	COMMUNITY COLLEGE BUILDING.
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22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-73-322 is amended to read as follows:
25	5-73-322. Concealed handguns in a university, college, or community
26	college building.
27	(a) As used in this section:
28	(1) "Hospital" means the facilities of an institution licensed,
29	certified, or approved by the Division of Health Facilities Services of the
30	Department of Health as a hospital which is primarily engaged in providing to
31	patients diagnostic and therapeutic services for medical diagnosis,
32	treatment, and care of injured, disabled, or sick persons, by or under the
33	supervision of a physician or other medical professional;
34	(1)(A)(2)(A) "Public university, public college, or community
35	college" means an institution that:
36	(i) Regularly receives budgetary support from the



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1 state government; 2 (ii) Is part of the University of Arkansas or 3 Arkansas State University systems; or 4 (iii) Is required to report to the Arkansas Higher 5 Education Coordinating Board. 6 "Public university, public college, or community (B) 7 college" does not include a private university or private college solely 8 because: 9 (i) Students attending the private university or 10 private college receive state-supported scholarships; or 11 (ii) The private university or private college 12 voluntarily reports to the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board; and 13  $\frac{(2)(3)(A)}{(2)}$  "Staff member" means a person who is not enrolled as a 14 full-time student at the university, college, or community college and is 15 either employed by the university, college, or community college: 16 (1) full Full time; or is on 17 (2) On a nine-month or twelve-month appointment at 18 the university, college, or community college as a faculty member; or 19 (3) As a part-time faculty member at the university, 20 college, or community college. 21 (B) "Staff member" does not include a graduate assistant. 22 (b) A licensee may possess a concealed handgun in the buildings and on 23 the grounds, whether owned or leased by the public university, public 24 college, or public community college, of the public university, public 25 college, or public community college where he or she is employed unless otherwise prohibited by this section or § 5-73-306 if + he or she is a staff 26 27 member. (1) He or she is a staff member; and 28 29 (2)(A) The governing board of the public university, public college, or public community college does not adopt a policy expressly 30 disallowing the carrying of a concealed handgun by staff members in the 31 buildings or on the grounds of the public university, public college, or 32 public community college and posts notices as described in § 5-73-306(19). 33 34 (B) A governing board of the public university, public college, or public community college may adopt differing policies for the 35 36 carrying of a concealed handgun by staff members for different campuses,

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1 areas of a campus, or individual buildings of the public university, public 2 college, or public community college for which the governing board is 3 responsible. 4 (C) A policy disallowing the carrying of a concealed 5 handgun by staff members into the public university, public college, or 6 public community college expires one (1) year after the date of adoption and 7 must be readopted each year by the governing board of the public university, 8 public college, or public community college to remain in effect. 9 (c) A licensee may possess a concealed handgun in the buildings and on 10 the grounds of the private university or private college where he or she is 11 employed unless otherwise prohibited by this section or § 5-73-306 if: 12 (1) He or she is a staff member; and 13 (2) The private university or private college does not adopt a 14 policy expressly disallowing the carrying of a concealed handgun in the 15 buildings and on the grounds of the private university or private college and 16 posts does not post notices as described in § 5-73-306(19). 17 The storage of a handgun in a university or college-operated (d)18 student dormitory or residence hall is prohibited under § 5-73-119(c). 19 (e)(1) The governing board of a public university, public college, or public community college that operates a public medical school may adopt a 20 policy expressly disallowing the carrying of a concealed handgun by a staff 21 22 member in the buildings or on the grounds of the public medical school that 23 are adjacent to or are up to within a radius of one-half (1/2) of a mile of 24 an associated public hospital. 25 (2) This subsection does not limit the governing board of a 26 public university, public college, or public community college from tailoring 27 its policy to permit the carrying of a concealed handgun into certain public hospital or public medical school facilities within the one-half-mile radius. 28 29 (3) A policy adopted under this subsection is invalid until 30 public notices as described under § 5-73-306(19) are posted in and around the parts of the public medical school and associated public hospital that are 31 32 subject to the policy. 33 (f)(1) The governing board of a public university, public college, or 34 public community college may adopt a policy expressly disallowing the 35 carrying of a concealed handgun by a staff member in the buildings or on the grounds of the public university, public college, or public community college 36

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1	which are adjacent to or are up to within a radius of one-half $(1/2)$ of a
2	mile of a federally owned and operated presidential library.
3	(2) This subsection does not limit the governing board of a
4	public university, public college, or public community college from tailoring
5	its policy to permit the carrying of a concealed handgun into certain
6	facilities where carrying a concealed handgun is not otherwise prohibited by
7	federal law within the one-half-mile radius.
8	(3) A policy adopted under this subsection is invalid until
9	public notices as described under § 5-73-306(19) are posted in and around the
10	parts of the public university, public college, or public community college
11	<u>that are adjacent to or up to within a radius of one-half (1/2) of a mile of</u>
12	<u>a federally owned and operated presidential library that are subject to the</u>
13	policy.
14	(g) A policy disallowing the carrying of a concealed handgun under
15	subsection (e) or subsection (f) of this section expires one (l) year after
16	the date of adoption and shall be readopted each year by the governing board
17	to remain in effect.
18	(h)(l) The governing board of a public university, public college, or
19	public community college may require a licensee to complete an active shooter
20	or related training program to be administered by the campus police
21	department or another law enforcement agency having jurisdiction in the
22	absence of a campus police department before a licensee who is a staff member
23	is permitted to carry a concealed handgun on the campus of the public
24	university, public college, or public community college.
25	(2)(A) A training program administered under this subsection
26	shall consist of up to sixteen (16) hours for initial training with a
27	subsequent annual requirement of up to eight (8) hours training.
28	(B) The costs of the training program under this
29	subsection shall not exceed a nominal amount.
30	(C) The training program under this subsection is not
31	required to be located on the campus of the public university, public
32	<u>college, or public community college but shall be reasonably accessible to a</u>
33	staff member who requests to attend the training program.
34	(D) A training program under this subsection shall be made
35	available at least one (1) time every three (3) months and notice of the
36	training program shall be given to staff members of the public university,

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1	public college, or public community college at least one (1) month in
2	advance.
3	(E) A campus police department or other law enforcement
4	<u>agency having jurisdiction shall maintain a list of licensees who have</u>
5	successfully completed a training program under this subsection.
6	(3) A staff member who attends a training program under this
7	subsection:
8	(A) Shall be:
9	(i) Allowed time off from his or her regular job
10	duties in order to attend the training program; or
11	(ii) Given compensatory time off for any time spent
12	attending the training program; and
13	(B) May not be charged leave for attending the training
14	program.
15	(4)(A) The training program under this subsection may be
16	designed by the campus police department, or it may be designed in
17	conjunction with the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and
18	Training or another law enforcement agency, including the campus police
19	department of another public university, public college, or public community
20	<u>college.</u>
21	(B)(i) A training program under this subsection shall at a
22	minimum have comparable standards to an active shooter or related training
23	program administered by the commission.
24	(ii) The governing board of a public university,
25	public college, or public community college may require higher standards for
26	its training program under this subsection than an active shooter or related
27	training program administered by the commission only if at least three (3) of
28	the following persons attend and complete the training program under this
29	subsection:
30	(a) A member of a governing board of the
31	public university, public college, or public community college;
32	(b) The president of the public university,
33	public college, or public community college or system;
34	(c) A chancellor of the public university,
35	public college, or public community college or system;
36	(d) A provost of the public university, public

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1	college, or public community college or system; or
2	(e) A dean of the public university, public
3	college, or public community college.
4	(5) A governing board of a public university, public college, or
5	public community college that adopts a policy requiring training under this
6	subsection shall renew the policy every five (5) years in order for the
7	policy to remain in force.
8	(6) Except for those persons enumerated under subdivision
9	(h)(4)(B)(ii) of this section, the names of licensees who complete a training
10	program under this subsection are exempt from the Freedom of Information Act
11	<u>of 1967, § 25-19-101 et seq.</u>
12	(i)(l) A staff member who is a licensee and who may carry a concealed
13	handgun on the campus of a public university, public college, or public
14	community college under this section may not carry a concealed handgun into a
15	daycare or childcare facility that is located on the campus of the public
16	university, public college, or public community college.
17	(2) A person who knowingly violates subdivision (i)(1) of this
18	section upon conviction is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.
19	(j) The governing board of a public university, public college, or
20	public community college may prohibit a person possessing an out-of-state
21	concealed handgun license that otherwise is valid in this state from carrying
22	a concealed handgun on the property or in a building of a public university,
23	public college, or public community college under this section.
24	(k) A public university, public college, or public community college
25	that permits a staff member who is a licensee to carry a concealed handgun
26	under this section shall submit to any local law enforcement agency having
27	jurisdiction a list of all staff members permitted to carry a concealed
28	handgun under this section upon request of the law enforcement agency having
29	jurisdiction.
