- 29 SUSPENSION OR REDUCTION OF FUNDS APPROPRIATED TO THE COMMUNITY INVESTMENT

- 1 OF APPROPRIATION. Subject to such rules and regulations as may be

INTER-AGENCY TRANSFER OF STATE GENERAL REVENUE FOR THE TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR 3 4 NEEDY FAMILIES (TANF) PROGRAMS. Upon the request of the Director of the 5 Department of Human Services (DHS) and the Director of the Department of 6 Workforce Services (DWS), the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may approve 7 up to three million six hundred forty thousand six hundred fifty dollars 8 (\$3,640,650) each fiscal year in State General Revenue appropriated to DWS 9 for the TANF program to be transferred to the DHS - Division of County 10 Operations in support of Arkansas' TANF Programs or any related separate 11 state programs. 12 The Director of the Department of Workforce Services shall provide a report of all transfers made to the DHS - Division of County Operations to 13 14 the Performance Evaluation and Expenditure Review Committee of the Arkansas 15 Legislative Council and Joint Budget Committee. The report must include the 16 justification for and the amount of the completed transfers. 17 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, -201418 2015 through June 30, 2015 2016. 19 20 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 21 22 OF TANF BLOCK GRANT FUNDS. Each fiscal year, the Department of Workforce 23 Services shall transfer the sum of seven million five hundred thousand 24 dollars (\$7,500,000) from the state's federal Temporary Assistance for Needy 25 Families block grant to the Department of Education Public School Fund 26 Account to be used solely for the Arkansas Better Chance Program. 27 If the state match for the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families grant 28 or the state's Temporary Assistance for Needy Families grant is reduced, the 29 amount to be transferred may be adjusted in proportion to the percentage 30 change in the state match or the state's Temporary Assistance for Needy 31 Families grant. The amount to be transferred may also be reduced 32 proportionately if new cost requirements are imposed upon the state as a 33 result of new or revised Temporary Assistance for Needy Families regulations 34 at the federal level.

SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRAINING TRUST FUND TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum of two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) from the Department of Workforce Services Training Trust Fund to the Arkansas Economic Development Commission Fund Account.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.

SECTION 24. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 25. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

 SECTION 26. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

1	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
2	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm
3	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
4	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
5	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
6	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
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
