SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 10 OF FUNDS - PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall 11 establish, upon request from the Department of Career Education, a special 12 appropriation line item to be used in the acquisition of promotional items. 13 When the Department of Career Education wishes to transfer monies from its 14 operating expenses appropriation to the Promotional Items line, the State 15 Board of Career Education shall approve the request and forward it after 16 receiving prior review and approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or 17 Joint Budget Committee, to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State for 18 processing. 19 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 20 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 21 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 22 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 23 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 24 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 25 has determined that the Department of Career Education may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Career
- 26 27 Education authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both
- 28 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by
- 29 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
- 30 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative
- 31 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.
- If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 33 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,
- 34 this entire section is void.

35 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 36 2015 through June 30, 2016.

2 SECTION 29. CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code § 6-51-904(a) is amended to 3 read as follows:

- 4 6-51-904. Duties of local board for technical institutes.
- 5 (a) The powers and duties of the local board shall be as follows:
- 6 (1) To acquire, hold, and transfer real and personal property, to enter 7 into contracts, to institute and defend legal actions and suits, and to 8 exercise such other rights and privileges as may be necessary for the 9 management and administration of the technical institute;
- 10 (2) To determine a minimum level for student tuition and fees to be 11 charged by the technical institute, including without limitation penalty 12 fees;
  - (3) To appoint from the candidates certified by the State Board of Career Education and approved by the Governor, the president of the technical institute or director of the comprehensive lifelong learning center;
- 16 (4) To appoint, upon nomination of the president or director, the 17 members of the administrative and teaching staffs;
  - (5) To determine, with the approval of the State Board of Career Education, the educational program of the institution; and
  - (6) Other powers and duties as provided in this subchapter or as delegated to it by the State Board of Career Education.

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SECTION 30. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 31. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

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6	SECTION 32. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
7	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
8	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
9	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of
10	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
11	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
12	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm
13	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
14	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
15	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
16	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
