- 27 EDUCATION DISTRIBUTION. All funds that become available for Adult Education

The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall 9 establish, upon request from the Department of Career Education, a special 10 appropriation line item to be used in the acquisition of promotional items. 11 When the Department of Career Education wishes to transfer monies from its 12 operating expenses appropriation to the Promotional Items line, the State 13 Board of Career Education shall approve the request and forward it after 14 receiving prior review and approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or 15 Joint Budget Committee, to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State for 16 processing. 17 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 18 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 19 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. 36 SECTION 31. CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code § 6-51-904(a) is amended to

- 2 6-51-904. Duties of local board for technical institutes.
- 3 (a) The powers and duties of the local board shall be as follows:
- 4 (1) To acquire, hold, and transfer real and personal property, to enter
- 5 into contracts, to institute and defend legal actions and suits, and to
- 6 exercise such other rights and privileges as may be necessary for the
- 7 management and administration of the technical institute;
- 8 (2) To determine a minimum level for student tuition and fees to be
- 9 charged by the technical institute, including without limitation penalty

8	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided; with the
9	exception that Section 24 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from
10	and after the date of its passage and approval, and that in the event of an
11	extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this
12	Act beyond July 1, 2015, with the exception that Section 24 in this Act shall
13	be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and
14	approval, could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and
15	provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is
16	hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate
17	preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force
18	and effect from and after July 1, 2015; with the exception that Section 24 in
19	this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its
20	passage and approval.
